Supplemental Information to Variance Request for Project Modifications

Dear Ms. Bose:

WBI Energy Transmission, Inc. (WBI Energy), herewith submits for filing with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) supplemental information to the variance request for project modifications filed with the FERC on April 26, 2018 in the above-referenced docket.

On May 8, 2018, the Fargo-Moorhead Metro Flood Diversion Authority (Diversion Authority) and WBI Energy reached agreement in principle on a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) for the Valley Expansion Project's (Project) crossing of the planned Fargo-Moorhead Area Diversion Channel (FMADC). The Diversion Authority expects to approve the MOU at its next scheduled board meeting on May 17, 2018, and a letter of support for WBI Energy's variance request related to the crossing of the FMADC and the addition of the Mainline Valve at milepost (MP) 29.7 is being provided as an attachment to this supplemental filing. WBI Energy will file a copy of the MOU with the FERC after the agreement is executed, in accordance with Environmental Condition 12 of the FERC's Order Issuing Certificate.

In addition, as noted in the April 26, 2018 variance request, relocation of the permanent access road to the Mainline Valve at MP 14.4 will cross an emergent wetland road ditch along 30th Street North. Approximately 0.01 acre of emergent wetland will be permanently impacted. WBI Energy has obtained all required federal permits and authorizations to relocate the permanent access road to the Mainline Valve at MP 14.4.

With this supplemental filing, WBI Energy respectfully requests written approval from the Director of the Office of Energy Projects for the requested project modifications as soon as possible.

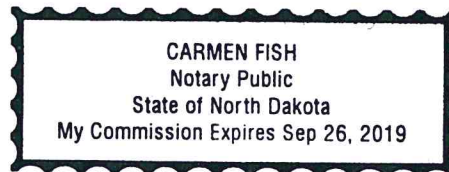
