Dear Acting Secretary Reese:

On June 4, 2024¹, WBI Energy Transmission, Inc. (WBI Energy) submitted a variance request for project modifications to WBI Energy's Wahpeton Expansion Project in accordance with Environmental Condition No. 5 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's (FERC or Commission) October 23, 2023 Order Issuing Certificate (Order) in the above referenced docket.

WBI Energy is hereby submitting supplemental information to the variance request by providing correspondences with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) and the North Dakota Department of Environmental Quality (NDDEQ) regarding the proposed Project modifications impacting wetland/waterbodies including Project modifications V2, V3, and V58. Proposed modifications will have minor impacts on wetlands and waterbodies and the USACE confirmed proposed modifications are covered under Nationwide Permit 12. The NDDEQ confirmed that proposed modifications do not impact the Section 401 Water Quality Certification for the Project.

Pursuant to 18 CFR § 385.2010 of the Commission's regulations, copies of this filing are being served to each person whose name appears on the official service list for this proceeding.

Hi Jason,

Hope all is well! As previously discussed, WBI Energy has made a few changes to its Wahpeton Expansion Project (USACE Project No. NWO-2021-1653-BIS). A map set depicting the proposed changes that impact wetland/waterbodies is attached for review. Some of these proposed changes occur outside of previously surveyed areas for the Project. Therefore, additional surveys were completed in April of 2024 at which time two previously surveyed waterbodies were extended, and two new waterbodies were identified. A report outlining the findings of these surveys is attached.

The table below summarizes the overall impact of these proposed variances to wetland/waterbodies:

*All impacts in the table are temporary except for the permanent impacts identified for VO2 and V14. P=Permanent T=Temporary

By incorporating these Project changes, temporary wetland impacts will decrease by approximately 0.7 acres (from 10.02 to 9.32 acres). Permanent water impacts will increase from 0.2 acres to 0.216 acres.

Please note that other Project changes have been made, however, only changes impacting delineated wetlands/waterbodies is included in this update. Please let me know if you need information on any of the other changes.

The project will continue to adhere to the conditions outlined in Nationwide Permit 12 and the DA PCN authorization for NWO-2021-1653-BIS dated 1/30/2024. Please let me know, at your earliest convenience, that the Project may proceed under the existing authorization.
