A. Update on Federal Authorizations

• WBI Energy has obtained all necessary federal permits and authorizations required for construction of the Wahpeton Expansion Project.

B. Construction Status - Pipeline Facilities

- Environmental Inspectors continue to conduct onsite environmental training as needed.
- WBI Energy shifted the project ROW approximately 10 feet west from Sta. No. 193+73 to 258+13 (Alignment Sheet Nos. 2 and 3) per two landowner requests. All activity will occur within survey corridors and no sensitive environmental resource areas will be affected. No other property owners are affected by the adjustment.
- On June 18, 2024, FERC approved variance request V64 for a project modification submitted on June 14, 2024.

- On June 13, 2024, an approximate 20- to 30-gallon diesel fuel spill occurred from a ruptured fuel line on a pipe truck as it was leaving the construction right-of-way, over construction mats, and onto a paved roadway (163rd Ave. SE). WBI Energy implemented measures identified in the Spill Prevention, Control and Countermeasure (SPCC) Plan to contain, clean up, and dispose of contaminated materials covering an approximate 1,000-square-foot (200-foot x 5-foot) area. Impacts were limited to the paved roadway surface and the equipment mats. No cultural or sensitive resources were impacted. Contaminated equipment mats were removed and hauled away for disposal at an approved facility. Spill reports were completed by the Spill Coordinator and Environmental Inspector onsite, the incident was reported using the North Dakota Department of Environmental Quality Unified Spill Reporting System, and affected landowners were notified.
