Re: WBI Energy Transmission, Inc. Wahpeton Expansion Project Docket No. CP22-466-000 Variance Request for Project Modification

Dear Acting Secretary Reese:

On October 23, 2023, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC or Commission) issued an Order Issuing Certificate (Order) in the above referenced docket authorizing WBI Energy Transmission, Inc. (WBI Energy) to construct, modify, operate, and maintain its Wahpeton Expansion Project (Project) in Cass and Richland Counties, North Dakota. On February 13, 2024, the Commission authorized WBI Energy to proceed with construction of all Project facilities.

Pursuant to Environmental Condition No. 5 of the Order, WBI Energy is hereby submitting a variance request to install a farm tap¹ (V70) near MP 56.9² in Richland County, North Dakota. WBI Energy has entered into an Interconnect Agreement with Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. (Montana-Dakota), a local distribution company, for the installation of the farm tap. Montana-Dakota will provide distribution service to the customer through the farm tap. All construction activities associated with the installation of the farm tap will be within approved workspaces, as depicted in Attachment A, with no change in construction acreage. The footprint of the farm tap (five feet by five feet) will be entirely within WBI Energy's approved permanent right-of-way, with additional above ground facility impacts of less than 0.01 acre.

¹ WBI Energy indicated in its application that the Project may include the installation of farm taps. WBI Energy stated a farm tap consists of valves and piping contained within a small, fenced enclosure typically 4 feet square and 3 feet high. (See eLibrary accession number 20220527-5343, Vol. I - Letter and Application; and Vol. II – RR1.)

The requested modification is located within the biological and cultural survey corridors³ for the Project and no further consultation is required. WBI Energy has received approval from the landowner for the installation of the farm tap.

No wetlands/waterbodies, cultural resources, or other environmental resources will be impacted by the installation of the farm tap. WBI Energy will implement the mitigation measures in FERC's *Upland Erosion Control, Revegetation, and Maintenance Plan*, and other permits/plans as applicable to further reduce impacts during construction and restoration.

The Project modification is not located within an environmental justice community.

As required under Environmental Condition No. 5 of the Order, WBI Energy respectfully requests written authorization from the Director of the Office of Energy Projects to utilize the requested Project modification, by Friday, September 20, 2024.


